This role will be responsible for the preparation, installation, and clean up for coating projects; residential and commercial. Physically fit people who have an eye for detail and enjoy manual labor thrive as coatings installers. Some nights and weekends may be required. The Installer position is a key link between customers and the success of Wisconsin Coating Specialists.

### Key Requirements

- Valid Driver's License & Reliable Transportation
- Ability to use hand tools and equipment unique to each type of floor coating process (i.e. grinders, vacuums, etc.)
- Ability to work on hands and knees during installations of coatings
- Excellent verbal communication skills & attention to detail
- Work as a team, with respect to all employees and customers
- Able to lift and carry a minimum of 50lbs with or without assistance
- Knowledge of mathematical reasoning (i.e. ratio measurements)
- Prior concrete knowledge (preferred)
- Prior installation of floor coatings (preferred)

### Responsibilities

- Arrive at the shop at scheduled time to help load the products needed for the job at the start of each shift and make sure the shop/trailers are clean
- Maintains equipment operating by following operating instructions
- Repairs to flooring substrate, application of coatings, and clean up
- Document service and installation products used
- End of workday processes (i.e. unloading of all project materials, returning any unused materials and clean the trailer out, etc.)
- Maintain polite/professional conduct and communication to ensure customer confidence
- Keep all service and customer information confidential
- Other general tasks that may arise in the shop to help further growth of business and employee needs
